Restrictions on the number of people in each area of the Garden Centre and one-way routes where necessary.



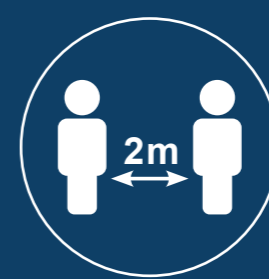
Shop only in small family groups; where possible we would prefer one person per household.
